- How do we help create social environments that develop, and don't choke, the spirit of the people and communities we work with?

The course is relevant to anyone exploring these questions: managers, policy makers, community and human services workers, volunteers and community members.

If you have real life examples of dilemmas or challenges in your work or activities, these can be explored through the day.
